Weekly Challenges (Have a go at as many as you can)	
Mon	Video Clip Last week we saw a video of Peppa Pig all about fruit. You can watch the video here: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=qjEkKYlkJcg How many different types of fruit were there? Which fruit do you like the most? Have you ever had a smoothie? What type of smoothie would you like to try?
Tues	Shopping list Can you make a shopping list for your smoothie? Think which fruits you would like to have. Would you like 'Dinosaur Juice'? Can you remember all the ingredients?
Wed	Make a Smoothie Can you make a smoothie to drink? Ask your parent to help you. Cut up the fruits and then ask your parent to help blend them together. How many different fruits did you use? Was it tasty?

Fri	My Favourite Fruits Can you draw a picture of your favourite fruits? You can draw or paint a picture of them. Can you write the names of each fruit? What do you like best about them?
