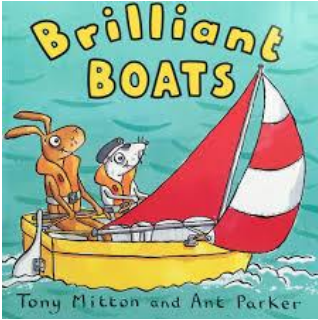


Reception: Week Beginning 15.6.2020

Weekly Challenges (Have a go at as many as you can)	
Mon	Story Time Listen to the story 'Brilliant Boats'. You can listen to the story here: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=KK7Au1u-xg How many different types of boats were there? Which boat did you like the most? Have you ever been on a boat? 
Tues	Design a Boat We are going to build a boat this week. What will you use to make your boat? Think about what materials could float on the water. Draw a picture of what your boat will look like. Can you label each part?  
Wed	Make your Boat Can you use your design to build your boat? Try to use the same materials you planned. You might have used plastic pots, lego or sticks. Does it need decorating? In the story it tells us many boats have a name, can you name your boat and write it on: 
Thurs	Test your Boat Once you have finished your boat, do you think it will float? Tell a grown up why you think that. This is called making a prediction. Now test your boat in water. Did it float? Did you predict the correct outcome? What could you have done differently? If it floats, how far can it travel? Can you make another and race them?
