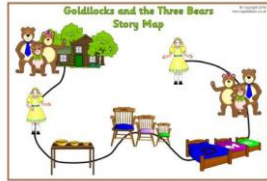
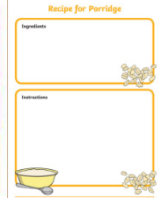
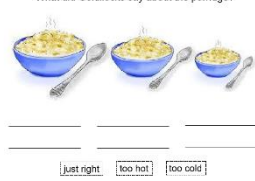
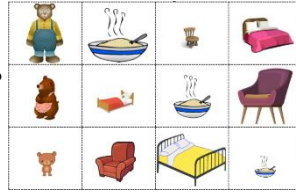


Reception: Week 6 - Week Beginning 18.5.2020

Weekly Challenges (Have a go at as many as you can)	
Mon	Story Maps Listen to the story of 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' You can watch the story here: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=0oUP2PFoI8 Can you draw what happens in the story? What does Goldilocks do first, next and last?  
Tues	Making Porridge Can you make porridge like the three bears? Can you add anything to your porridge to make it extra tasty? Maybe try honey, berries or jam. What was your favourite? Can you write a recipe to make porridge?   
Wed	Writing Labels Can you label the three bear's bowls? Which one was too hot, too cold, or just right? What about the three bear's chairs? Which one was too hard, too soft, or just right?  
Thurs	Size ordering Can you order things by size? You could try to find three bears around your house? Can you find three different sized bowls? Or three different sized spoons? Which is the biggest? Which one is the smallest? Use the size ordering cut-out sheets to help you if you need it.  
Fri	Goldilocks and the Three Bears Pictures Can you make a picture of Goldilocks and the three Bears? You could draw, paint, colour or collage your picture. Instead of a picture you could make puppets, masks or story spoons. Maybe you would like to just do your favourite character from the story.
