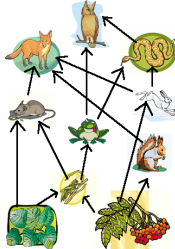
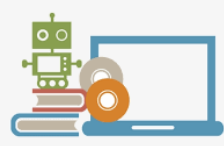


Activities	
1	<u>Stone Age – Neolithic Farmers</u> We are now entering the New Stone Age known as the Neolithic age. One of the most significant developments in the whole of human history was the invention of farming. Look at the powerpoint about farming in the stone age. Compare the life of a farmer to a hunter gatherer. How were these differences beneficial or limiting? Write a persuasive argument about whether, if you could go back in time, you would be a hunter-gatherer or a farmer with evidence to back up your viewpoint. 
2	<u>Science - Living Things</u> Look at the Food Chain Challenge in the Woodland on: https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zbnbn9q/articles/zsphrwx Find a producer – a plant that makes its own food from sunlight. Find a consumer that eats the producer. Find another consumer that eats meat. 
3	<u>Music 3 - Melody and Pitch</u> Melody is the tune (the part of the music that you often find yourself singing along with) and pitch is how high or low a note sounds.
