Activities	
1	<u>The Bog Baby</u> Listen to the story of 'The Bog Baby' https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=nVuH4BdVQQQ Can you draw the Bog Baby? Can you add labels to describe what it looks like? 
2	<u>Make your own Bog Baby</u> Some children made their very own Bog Babies. Look at these lovely ideas. Can you make a Bog Baby? You could decorate a stone or maybe use a pom pom. What does your Bog Baby look like? Will it have wings and a spikey tail? 
3	<u>Bog Baby habitat</u> Where do Bog Babies live? What is their habitat like? It might be worth listening to the story again for clues. Using an old container – can you make a habitat for a Bog Baby to live in? Remember it will need some shelter and food sources – I wonder what they eat? Send us a photo of your habitats, it would be interesting to see your designs. 
4	<u>History – Grace Darling</u> Watch the video to find out about a famous person called Grace Darling. https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/class-clips-video/true-stories-grace-darling/z4y7pg8 Why did Grace become so famous? Can you draw the key parts of her story? 
5	<u>The miracles of Jesus</u> Watch the story of Jesus walking on water https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=oVy9HGr3Qig It's not always easy to trust others. Who do you trust completely? Can you draw that person? What qualities do they have that make you trust them completely?
