2	Bird nests Every Spring, birds are busy building their nests. Do you know why birds build nests? Can you find out? Have a go at building your own nest (it might not be as easy as it looks!) Use the sheets to help you and have a go at answering the questions. 
3	Nature's music There is so much to do in our outdoors. Why not follow the instructions to make some music using natural objects? Follow the instructions – or make your own?!
