



Activities	
1	Feed the birds Click on the link to the cbeebies website https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/makes/bird-feeder Choose a bird feeder to make. I wonder which birds will be attracted to your feeders? Extension – Can you write some step by step instructions so someone else can make your feeder? 
2	Bird watching If you haven't already, have a go at birdwatching from your window. Tally how many birds come to your garden. Use the bar chart template to show how many birds you've seen. 
3	Reading Read or listen to a book of your choice. Draw your favourite part from that book. Write some sentences to describe the main character. What do they look like? What's their personality like? 
4	Find out about the UK Follow the link to BBC Bitesize https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/articles/z42pnrd and find out about the four countries of the UK and their capital cities. Watch the videos and have a go at some of the activities.
