

Google Classroom & Google Drive

How to share work with your teacher when not submitting an assignment

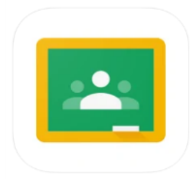
We are very aware that so many excellent pieces of work are being completed at home and we very keen to see the children's super work! Here is a quick guide to show you how you can share your child's work with their teacher.

Method 1 – uploading to a specific assignment

1. Download the Google Drive and Google Classroom app to a phone/iPad/appropriate smart device from the App Store or Google Play



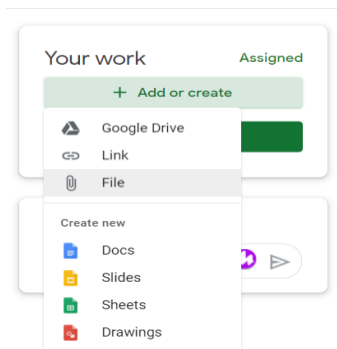

Google Classroom

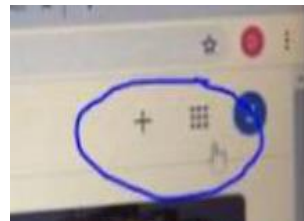
2. Use the camera in the app or on your device to take photos/videos of your work

(If you do this in the app on the Google Classroom assignment you can click '+ Add or Create' and select the paperclip to add your photo/video as an attachment or take your photo straight from the assignment)

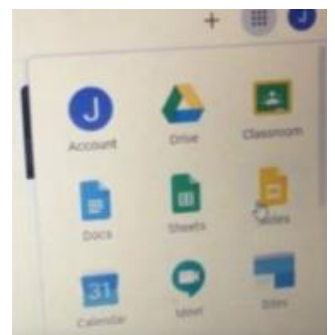


Method 2 – Keep a weekly learning journal

1. Go to Google Classroom and click on the 9 dots in the top right corner



2. Create a document, e.g. Google Slides and you could create a presentation every week of any home learning you do that you don't need to submit as an assignment. You can include photos/video of you completing art work, PE lessons, outdoor tasks or any additional tasks you have done. You can also include photos of any written work/pictures/drawings.
