

When things ARE going well

Verbal praise

When you have worked extremely hard or you have really improved on something you might have struggled with - you will be told how well you've done.



Written Praise

When you have put a lot of effort into your work then you will receive a written comment about the great work you have completed.



Star of the week

If you have achieved something outstanding during the week or if you have risen to a challenge, you might be awarded star of the week in your class.

When things ARE NOT going

1.Warning

If you are talking over someone, annoying someone, being off task, or interrupting teaching and learning time, you will



2. Time out table

If you continue to behave poorly, you will be sent to the time out table and miss 5 minutes of your next play time.



3. Missing time

If you are ignoring instructions, using unkind names, being physical, or being rude to an adult you will be asked to reflect on your behaviour. You will also miss 10 minutes of your play time.



4. See the Headteacher

If you continue to ignore instructions, upset other children with unkind language, physically hurt someone or be very rude to an adult then you will miss all of your play time. You will also discuss your behaviour with the Headteacher and complete a reflection sheet.



5. Internal exclusion

If you seriously hurt someone on purpose, or continue the behaviour described above then you will spend the rest of the day with the head teacher completing work on your own. You will also complete a reflection sheet.
