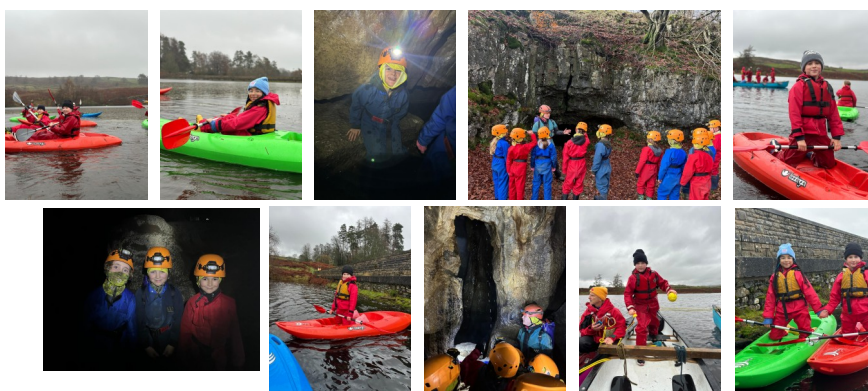
High Borrans
